



HOUSE RULES

1. Players must be 18 years of age.
2. Reserving or holding a seat(s) is not allowed. Guest must buy-in first before finding a seat. Any personal items left on tables are subject to removal by Bingo Staff and/or Security.
3. Only one computer per person is allowed. Any machine malfunctions voids all pays and plays.
4. A valid government issued ID is required for all Club Card transactions and credit/debit purchases.
5. All sales are final. Refunds or bingo credit for missing or unused games will require approval from Bingo Management.
6. All cell phones and other devices must be kept on silent, vibrate, or turned off while in session.
7. Each guest is responsible for playing all their own games purchased. Bingo Clerks may cover temporarily but are not responsible for missing Bingos. **FAMILY OR FRIENDS MAY PLAY OR WATCH YOUR CARDS IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY OR WHEN IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT BINGO DOES NOT HAVE ENOUGH CLERKS TO HELP COVER.** You must make every attempt to call a Clerk or Management for coverage. Management will determine all factors before validating a Bingo with these conditions.
8. Each guest must have their valid and signed admissions slip in view at all times. No ticket-sharing or pack-splitting is allowed. Guests who share bingo packs will not be paid. After declaring Bingo, guest is to provide the Clerk with their valid admissions slip. If the guest cannot provide the Clerk with an admissions slip, Bingo Management will make the decision to verify or invalidate the Bingo.
9. **IT IS THE PLAYERS' RESPONSIBILITY TO SAY "BINGO" LOUD ENOUGH TO STOP "THE CALLER" AND STOP THE GAME PRIOR TO ANY PORTION OF THE NEXT BALL BEING CALLED. BINGO STAFF MEMBERS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR STOPPING THE GAME FOR YOU.** If a player does not stop the caller from announcing any portion of the next number, that potential Bingo will be considered invalid and no payout will be made.
10. Once the caller announces "The Game is Now Closed", only those cards declared as a valid Bingo will be honored. A Bingo is only valid when won on the last number called.
11. Only the actual draw objects, which can be verified from those that have been drawn, are officially recognized for game play. The numbers on the flash-boards are for the players' convenience only. Management is not responsible for any verbal or nonverbal errors from staff.
12. Table Mountain Casino Resort is not responsible for any lost cards, admission slips, or personal property.
13. In the event there are multiple winners during a game, the posted prize will be divided equally among the winners for that game.
14. A valid ID and Social Security Card are required for any winnings exceeding the amount of \$1,199. No transfers of winnings to another player will be allowed.
15. Management reserves the right to cancel any session or adjust the payouts based on attendance.
16. Management reserves the right to interpret all of the above rules and make determinations based on the studied information presented from staffing or guests. All decisions made by Bingo Management are final.

JACKPOT RULES

HOTBALLS

Two Hotball Jackpots offered. Requires an additional purchase in Admissions for \$1 and \$2. Hotball numbers are only valid on Regular session games. In order to win one of the Hotball Jackpots, you must Bingo on the preselected Hotball number announced by the Bingo Caller at the beginning of the Bingo session and hold a valid receipt. Prize payouts will be posted. Table Mountain Hotball Jackpots are awarded on both single and shared Bingos. Regular games pay only the advertised program prize when no Hotball has been purchased. Hotballs start at \$500 and grow progressively. Each Hotball increases daily until the jackpot is won. Once a Hotball is won, the prize amount will reset to the starting prize for the rest of the session.

MULTI ACTION

Played on a red one-on sheet with two numbers per square for \$2. When either number is called, both numbers in that square can be daubed. When a player bingos in 38 numbers or less, the game will payout the posted Jackpot. Jackpot starts at \$1,500 and increases \$50 each session the game is played. Consolation prizes for this game range from \$250-\$1000.

DIAMOND G

Played on a tan nine-on-sheet for \$2. Two games played on one sheet, the first game being a large diamond that pays \$250, second game is a blackout. The first G ball higher than 48 out of the blower is the target Bingo and pays the Jackpot prize. Jackpot starts at \$1,500 and increases \$250 every Sunday. Consolation prize is \$500 under the first G ball called and \$250 after the first G ball called.

TMC COVERALL

Played on a pink three-on-sheet for \$2. Use the first 40 numbers called before session to pre-mark your cards. Jackpot prize starts at \$1500 for a Bingo in 48 numbers or less and increases \$100 and one number each Sunday. Jackpot prize is won from a coverall in the number of balls in the posted prize. Consolation prize of \$250 is won after a Bingo exceeds the numbers called in the posted prize.

CRYSTAL BALL/TM PICK 8

Played on an orange three-on sheet for \$3. Cards are only sold as quick picks, numbers are randomly chosen through the system. The jackpot prize is won off eight numbers within the first twenty numbers called. \$750 won off eight numbers within 21-24 numbers called. Consolation prize of \$500 is won after 25+ numbers called. The posted jackpot starts at \$1500 and increases \$250 each Sunday unless it's won at \$750, otherwise it remains the same.

JACKPOT BONANZA

Played on a purple three-on-sheet for \$2. Use the first 40 numbers called before session to pre-mark your cards. Jackpot prize is won off a coverall in 49 numbers or less. Consolation prize of \$500 is won for 50 balls or more. Jackpot starts at \$1500 and increases \$200 every Sunday if not won.

STRIP TICKET

Played over multiple styles of Strip tickets, all \$5 each. Strip tickets are only purchased as paper. Winners will receive all or their share of a \$250 or \$500 payout. Payout is dependent upon sales.

Management reserves the right to interpret all of the above rules and make determinations based on the studied information presented from staffing or guests. All decisions made by Bingo Management are final.
